

RED: CRITICAL STAGE

Hours of Operation 24/7

- Evacuation Order given: Full or Partial
- Evacuee Coordinator and Assistants hired
- Establish Evacuation Centre
- May need extra transportation for evacuees
- Contact additional personal
 - Re: specific needs, equipment
- Consult/Contact other Communities, First Nations
 - Re: Any possible road closures
- Increased meetings to twice a day
- Increase gauge measurement readings
- Home/ Property inspections
- Prioritize removal of stranded evacuees
- Increase in staff
 - Hiring's are from surrounding communities which are priority
- Direct all effected departments to implement their evacuation plans
- For safety reasons any or all flood proof work may/will be stopped during night where roads/driveways are compromised

The following are constant:

-Update/Review/Revise current Emergency Operations Centre Policy/Procedures

-Contact/Consult Finance Team

-Band and/or Flood

-Establish/follow budgets

-Contact/Consult Project Manager and/or Emergency Coordinator

-Contact/Consult Security Director and/or RCMP

-Contact/Consult with Health

Re: Priority list of evacuees

-Contact/Consult Education

Re: Graduates as priority

-Contact/Consult Media Officials

-Contact/Consult with Safety Officer

-Contact/Consult Chief/Council, MANFF, and AANDC

-Contact/Consult RED CROSS/Humane Society
