Requirements

-  Original and Valid
-  French or English
-  Issued by a Federal, Provincial, Territorial or State Government Authority
-  Name, Date of Birth, Photo, and Signature included

Supporting identity documents that can be used as singular identification



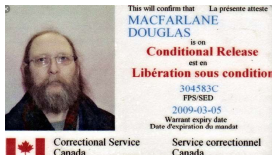
Provincial/Territorial Driver's License (including enhanced)



Passport



Provincial/Territorial Identification Card (including enhanced)



Federal Correctional Services Document



SCIS (less than 12 months past expiry date or for child/dependant adult applications)



Canadian or U.S. Permanent Resident Card (with signature)



Canadian Military Identification



Provincial/Territorial Health Card (ON, QC, BC only)



Canadian Citizenship Card (*issued prior to February 1, 2012*)



Social Worker's Employment ID (applications for children in care)

Supporting identification, that when combined meet all of the requirements (Name, DOB, Photo, and Signature)



Certificate of Indian Status (less than 6 months past expiry date)



Provincial/Territorial Health Card (that doesn't meet all requirements)



Firearms License



Canadian Permanent Resident Card (without signature and issued after Feb 1, 2012)



Government Employee I.D.



NEXUS or FAST card



U.S. Passport Card / U.S. Old Age Security Card
