

PEGUIS FIRST NATION REMAINS IN LEVEL 5

As of **Tuesday, JANUARY 6, 2022**, 12:01 a.m. (midnight), Peguis First Nation remains under a State of Emergency, extended indefinitely, with Peguis Public Health Orders in effect. Current Peguis Public Health Orders in effect for Peguis 1B are:

| Isolation and General Safety | |

| Self-Isolation (Quarantine) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contacts of a positive case must complete a mandatory isolation for 10 days and self-monitor for 4 days following. Testing will be done on day 1 and day 7. If you develop any symptoms, while in isolation, please report to Peguis Public Health or COVID-19 Command Centre. • Due to COVID-19 Variants of Concern, all contacts, regardless of vaccination status, MUST isolate and be tested as per community health guidelines. • The ENTIRE HOUSEHOLD must isolate if: A positive case is in the house; A contact of a positive case is in the house; A person in the house is waiting for test results; A person in the house is isolating; Anyone that is symptomatic, even if its minor cold symptoms, needs to isolate and be tested. • Critical staff including health care, safety and security identified as a contact may be required to continue working if needed. This may apply to critical staff that test negative after 5 days isolation and are symptom free. • Travel Out of Province: Anyone returning to community from out of province is required to isolate for 4 days regardless of vaccination status. • Individuals who are incarcerated, returning to community and are not fully immunized: 10 days of isolation, test done on day 7. No isolation for those fully immunized. • Only essential parcels/deliveries allowed for isolating households. |
| General Safety | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Face Masks are required in all public settings; Practice social distancing when in public; Frequently wash hands for 20 seconds; Self-Isolate and notify the 24/7 Peguis COVID-19 Command Centre at (204) 645-2869 when feeling symptomatic. • N-95 Face Masks are required for all indoor office settings. • Prepare your household in case you need to isolate. |

| <p>Gatherings/ Visiting/</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • STAY AT HOME ORDER: In effect January 10, 2022 until January 31, 2022. No visiting at this time. Members are asked to “Stick to your Household Bubble” and refrain from accepting visitors from outside your household bubble. Only travel for essential shopping and services. Designate 1 household shopper for essential shopping. • Visitors from outside the community must pre-register by calling (204) 645-2869 or (204) 645-4738. Home makers are not going into Elder’s homes, close family can request to check on loved ones. • No Parties or gatherings allowed where alcohol is involved. Fines will be issued to the homeowner. • Indoor Gatherings on Private Property: No visiting at this time • Indoor Gatherings in Public Spaces: Group sizes limited to 25 people or 25% capacity, whichever is lower, for gatherings that include unvaccinated people who are eligible to be vaccinated. Groups of fully immunized people and those under 12 who are not eligible for the vaccine may gather without capacity limits. • Outdoor Gatherings on Private Property: No visiting at this time. • Outdoor Gatherings in Public Spaces: Permitting groups of up to 50 people in uncontrolled outdoor public spaces. • Indoor Weddings: Limited to 25 people or 25% capacity, whichever is lower, for gatherings that include unvaccinated people who are eligible to be vaccinated. Proof of vaccination required for events held in licensed facilities. • Outdoor Weddings: Limited to 50 people, or if an outdoor venue has a capacity limit, the allowed capacity is 50% or 150 people, whichever is greater. Proof of vaccination required for events held in licensed facilities. • Indoor Religious/Cultural/Community Gatherings: Limited to 50% capacity with proof of vaccination, or 25% capacity or a total of 25, whichever is lower, when proof of vaccination is not required. Face masks must be worn at all times. • Outdoor Religious/Cultural/Community Gatherings: Limited to 50 people in uncontrolled outdoor public spaces. Drive in services continue unrestricted. • Indoor Self-Help Gatherings: Limited to 50 people or 50% capacity. • Palliative Care visits are allowed but each visitor must pre-register. |
| <p>Travel/ Medical Travel</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only travel for essential shopping at this time. Outdoor activities such as sliding, skating and ice fishing are allowed within your household bubble. • Medical Travel (outside of the community) requires 4-day self-monitor, avoid local businesses and contact with anyone. |
| <p>Office/ Business</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Peguis Band Employees: Alternating critical staff until further notice. Offices closed to public until January 31, 2021. • Peguis Central School: Closed until January 31, 2021. Remote learning in effect. |

| | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multiplex/Recreation: Fitness Centre and track closed until further notice. All activities postponed until further notice. • Peguis VLT's: Closed until further notice. • Peguis Home Hardware: Limit of 2 customers, Curb Side Pick-Up available by calling (204) 372-6562. • Peguis Family Foods: Limit of 10 customers. Designate 1 household shopper for essential shopping. Delivery and Curb Side Pick-Up starting soon. • Peguis Midway: Limit of 2 customers, open regular hours. • Peguis Senior Home: Visitors and home visits are not allowed until further notice. |
| <p>Vaccines/ COVID-19 Tests</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Testing occurs on day 1 and day 7 for those who are isolating. Clients who are symptomatic but are fully vaccinated, or within the 6-month reinfection timeline need to isolate and be tested. • VACCINES: Peguis, Dallas, Harwill residents are eligible for a Moderna vaccine (18+ yrs), Pfizer (5+ yrs) and 3rd dose vaccines for those 18+. Walk-In's welcome for vaccine at Peguis Health Centre. • Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are available to First Nation members, residing outside the community at Manitoba Super Sites, 1-844-626-8222 (1-844-MAN-VACC). Daily hours are 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. • Immunization Cards available at https://immunizationcard.manitoba.ca. If you experience problems accessing your card, please call the Peguis Health Centre at (204) 645-2169 for assistance. |
| <p>Provincial Fines</p> | <p>R.C.M.P. are issuing fines to anyone who is not following public health orders put in place by the Manitoba Public Health Act.</p> |
